Walking 1066 Harold's Way: Ordnance Survey



In the 2019 Guide to Walking 1066 Harold's Way, there are indicative maps that only show the general route of 1066 Harold's Way. In the place of the original hand drawn maps, and to take advantage of the excellent mapping available from Ordnance Survey, full mapping of all the routes is available to download to your smartphone or GPS.

Access to the Ordnance Survey Map App is vital and will allow you to follow the route on your Smartphone without fear of becoming lost - the app is available to download for both Apple and Android. OS Map App links are given in the Information Panels for each walk but to make life easier, here is a full list of all the routes and hyperlinks that will take you directly to each section's route. Each route can be printed off, downloaded to Smartphone or transferred to GPS by following the OS instructions.

Use the free trial to print all the maps or subscribe to OS to for full access to OS Mapping.
